
Pilgrimage from Sarria to Santiago de Compostela Saturday, September 19, 2020-Saturday, September 26, 2020

Saturday, September 19th – Saturday, September 26, 2020

The pilgrimage begins on Saturday, September 19th, at 5:00 pm, in Sarria and ends in Santiago de Compostela on Saturday, September 26th, after breakfast. After registration, you will receive additional information to help you make your travel plans to Sarria, Spain.

The Camino is an ancient pilgrim route that begins in many places around the world. There is a saying that "all roads lead to Santiago". Our pilgrimage will take place in Spain and we will walk the last 110 kilometers of the Camino Frances. We will begin with a welcome reception and dinner in Sarria and after a night of rest, we will begin walking the next morning.

Day 1 (Sat)	Sept 19: Welcome reception & dinner (gather at 5:00 pm in Sarria)
Day 2 (Sun)	Sarria to Portomarin (20 km/12.43 mi)
Day 3 (Mon)	Portomarin to Lestedo (19 km/11.8 mi)
Day 4 (Tues)	Lestedo to Melide (19 km/11.8 mi)
Day 5 (Wed)	Melide to Arzua (14 km/8.7 mi)
Day 6 (Thur)	Arzua to Pedrouzo (O Piño) (19 km/11.8 mi)
Day 7 (Fri)	Pedrouzo (O Piño) to Santiago (20 km/12.43 km)
Day 8 (Sat)	Breakfast, Benediction & Farewell

Price \$1,300 + \$300 non-refundable deposit= \$1,600 total for the pilgrimage

The price covers reception, 7 overnight stays with breakfasts and dinners, daily baggage transfers on walking days, pilgrim credential and pilgrim shell.

Not included: individual travel to Sarria and from Santiago & lunches

The balance is due by August 20, 2020. As of August 20, 2020, if participant cancels, the non-refundable deposit and an additional 25% of the registration will be withheld, unless you find someone else who can take your place.
